## LAW OFFICES OF BRUCE J. CHASAN, LLC ANNOUNCES FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT AND APOLOGY IN ABUSE OF PROCESS LAWSUIT

The Law Offices of Bruce J. Chasan, LLC and attorney Chasan are pleased to announce a favorable resolution of the matter *Freundlich & Littman, LLC v. Feierstein, No.* 150401569 (Phila. Co.), in which Chasan was sued for abuse of process.

Plaintiffs have settled with Chasan, and in doing so, they paid Chasan \$40,000, and Attorney Gregory C. Littman penned a public letter of apology for making unfounded allegations against Chasan of criminal witness intimidation and other professional misconduct.

Importantly, Mr. Littman's Apology Letter contradicts and undermines the holding of *Chasan v. Littman*, No. 2928 EDA 2016, 2019 Pa. Super. Unpub. LEXIS 321 (Pa. Super. January 29, 2019), in which the Superior Court affirmed a summary judgment dismissing Chasan's defamation case. The court held Littman had a "reasonable belief" that Chasan was involved in criminal witness intimidation. Inexplicably, the Court relied on deposition testimony of James Schwartzman who expressed an opinion that Chasan was involved in criminal witness intimidation, but admitted he was speculating and had no evidence.

Chasan commends Mr. Littman for finally admitting his error and apologizing for the harm caused. Schwartzman's opinions were held inadmissible in motions in limine in the abuse of process litigation, now settled.
